MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Bishop Brendan Cahill has encouraged the parishes of the Diocese of Victoria to be involved in the *V Encuentro* (5th Encounter). The main goal of the *V Encuentro* is to discern ways in which the Church in the United States can better respond to the Hispanic presence and strengthen ways in which Hispanics respond to the call of the New Evangelization as missionary disciples serving all the church. The Church in the United States has done this four times before. We held a Parish *Encuentro* on November 21, 2017 to name the priorities and recommendations for the Parish. The members of our parish team also committed themselves to being delegates to the Diocesan *Encuentro* on Saturday, February 17th in El Campo. They are: **Maribel & Elias Flores, Sylvia Garcia, Roberto Macias, Raquel Manzano, Arturo Pérez, Claudia & Juan Vasquez and Yesenia Vasquez.** Out of this meeting eighteen delegates will be chosen to attend a statewide *Encuentro* training in April in San Antonio. Eighteen of the statewide *Encuentro* delegates will be chosen to attend a National *Encuentro* in September. Please hold all the delegates in prayer.
