## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

For the last couple of years, after the evening blessings at the graves at Sacred Heart Cemetery on **November 2<sup>nd</sup>**, **All Souls Day (Día de los Muertos/Day of the Dead)**, I longed to stay longer with a little food and drinks in conversation with those who were paying their respects for the dead, a simple version of what is done in Mexico. So, this year I invite us to do just that: bring finger foods to the bench area under the large cedar trees; drinks, cups and napkins will be provided, and we'll celebrate with those who have gone before us.

**THE WRAP CAMPAIGN** (White Ribbon Against Pornography) is held each year at the end of October. Norma Norris of Butler, Pa., began the White Ribbon Week in 1987 after hearing a sermon against pornography delivered by her parish priest, Msg. Francis Glenn. Norma used a simple white ribbon as a symbol of decency to inform the public of the harm done by exposure to pornography. The National center on Sexual Exploitation has expanded the campaign to include human trafficking and the physical abuse of women and children.

In support of this campaign, Catholic Daughters Court Sacred Heart of Mother Teresa #2570, Flatonia, will hand out white ribbons and a prayer card after Mass on October 28 & 29 (SH). We hope you will wear the ribbon and join us in prayer this week as we work to end the harm caused by pornography.
