MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

I ask Sacred Heart parishioners to join me in praising God for **Buddy Borel**. He made and installed the hand railing in the SH altar area and he did so within the week of me asking him if he could do it. You will notice that his artisanship is still top quality, as in the altar candle stands he did for us years ago.

At the 9:30 Eucharist next Sunday our 10th grade Sacred Heart catechumen, **José Manzano**, will be sent to Bishop Brendan Cahill for the Rite of Election. This ceremony is the second step of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) for José, on our journey with him to Baptism, Confirmation, and sharing fully in the Eucharist at the this Easter Vigil, the third last step of the RCIA. The last period of the RCIA for José will be the rest of his spiritual development throughout his life, just like for all of us baptized Christians; but more about that in the Easter Season.
