MESSAGE FROM FATHER EDDIE

At the 9:30 AM Eucharist this Sunday, we began praying in a special way with our own member of the elect: **José Martínez** (tenth grade), using the first of three scrutinies of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). We will celebrate two more scrutinies with José, as the RCIA has scrutinies prepared for the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent. "The scrutinies...are rites of self-searching and repentance and have above all a spiritual purpose. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good." If you think about it, that is the Lenten goal for all of us.

I encourage you to look at your calendars and consider attending the 10:00 AM Chrism Mass at the Cathedral in Victoria on Tuesday of Holy Week, March 27th.

Los escrutinios tienen por objeto el descubrir y posteriormente el sanar todo aquello que es débil, defectuoso o pecaminoso en los corazones de los elegidos; y resaltar y luego fortalecer todo lo que es recto, fuerte y bueno." Si piensas en ello, esa es la meta cuaresmal de todos nosotros.*
