## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

I feel a need to repeat what I focused on in my preaching at Baccalaureate on Pentecost Sunday evening, May 20<sup>th</sup>, that is, the mental wellness of our community, the general US society, and of our families. As we grieve once again because of the killings at Santa Fe High School on May 18<sup>th</sup>, I hear very little talk about mental illness and family relationships, and mostly discussion over gun control and its political ramifications. Yes, I do think there needs to be developments in gun control, but I believe the greater issue is the lack of availability and utilization of mental health services and the stigma that persists amongst us over going to counseling and speaking out when we recognize someone is in need of help. If we are to understand patience, kindness and faithfulness as fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5:16-25, Second Reading, Solemnity of Pentecost, cycle B), then we must see these fruits as acts of forgiveness. In the specific case of school shootings, utilizing psychological counseling services more would be an effective appropriation of these fruits.

*Siento la necesidad de repetir lo que me enfoqué en mi predicación en el Baccalaureate el día 20 de mayo por la noche del domingo de Pentecostés, es decir, el bienestar mental de nuestra comunidad, la sociedad general de los EE. UU. y de nuestras familias. Cuando nos lamentamos una vez más por los homicidios en Santa Fe High School el 18 de mayo, escuché muy poco acerca de las enfermedades mentales y las relaciones familiares, y principalmente sobre el control de armas y sus ramificaciones políticas. Sí, creo que es necesario que haya avances en el control de armas, pero creo que el problema mayor es la falta de disponibilidad y utilización de los servicios de salud mental y el estigma que persiste entre nosotros en ir a la consejería y hablar cuando reconocemos que alguien está en necesidad de ayuda. Si queremos entender lo que es paciencia, bondad y fidelidad como frutos del Espíritu (Gálatas 5: 16-25, Segunda lectura, la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, ciclo B), entonces debemos ver estos frutos como actos de perdón. En el caso específico de tiroteos escolares, una mayor utilización de servicios de asesoramiento psicológico sería una apropiación efectiva de estos frutos.*
